TO OUR NEW PARISHIONERS: If you are new to our parish or have lived in the neighbourhood and attend Mass but just never registered, we invite you to become an official member of St Joseph's Parish. Your registration is a part of being an active and responsible member of our Parish community. There are registration forms in the back of the church or in the sacristy. Please fill them out and put them in the collection basket, mail them to our Parish or give them to the priest.

The Parish membership will enrol you automatically in our Planned Giving System where your donations to the Parish will be recorded.

If you are not able to financially support our church, you can donate your time as a volunteer on a weekly basis, in lieu of your donation. Please indicate this on the form.

It is important to be a registered member of a parish since membership is required in the Catholic Church for various sacramental occasions such as: Marriage, Baptism of a child, Funeral or to serve as a godparent or sponsor for Confirmation even if the Sacrament will take place in a different parish.

BAPTISM: Prior to having a child baptized at St Joseph's, you must have been registered in the parish for at least four months, attending Sunday Mass each week, using the stewardship envelopes (even if you cannot afford to contribute, please put an envelope in the collection basket), and participating in the life of the parish (make yourself known to the priest and be involved in parish activities).

Baptisms take place on Sundays at 11:15am after the **10:00am Mass**.

Attending a Baptism Preparation Class is required and may be attended prior to the birth of a child.

VATICAN CITY : - 5 June 2013 (VIS)

Pope Francis dedicated the catechesis of today's Wednesday morning general audience to the environment. Noting that Wednesday marked the World Environment Day promoted by the United Nations.

"When we speak of the environment, of creation, my thoughts go to the first pages of the Bible, to the Book of Genesis, where it is affirmed that God puts man and woman on earth 'to cultivate and care for it'. And the question comes to me". The Pope said "What does it mean to cultivate and care of the earth? Are we truly cultivating and caring for creation? Or are we exploiting and neglecting it?"

"Cultivating and caring for creation is God's indication, given not only at the beginning of history, but to each one of us. It is part of his plan. It means responsibly making the world grow, transforming it so that it becomes a garden, a place that all can inhabit."

"Cultivating and caring for doesn't just refer to our relationship with the environment, the relationship between humanity and creation. It also concerns human relationships. ...We are living a moment of crisis. We see it in the environment but above all we see it in humanity.

Following proclamation of the Privacy Act 1988 at the end of 2001, a privacy policy has been developed in accordance with Diocesan norms and has been approved by the Parish Priest. A copy is available from the Parish Office.
